

Notice to Investigators Regarding Billing for Mileage

If the circuit ISC allowed for mileage for investigators then the investigator may only bill for mileage in limited circumstances. As a general rule, investigators are paid hourly and that hourly fee includes ordinary travel. Investigators are only paid for extraordinary mileage. Extraordinary mileage includes travel between counties or a trip exceeding 50 miles one way within a county. In instances involving multiple destinations within a county, the total mileage for the trip must exceed 100 miles. An out-of-county investigator may not bill for mileage between the investigator's office and the county of the case unless there is an order authorizing the retention of an out-of-county investigator or an order specifically identifying the investigator.
